

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINE
BY MASSACHUSETTS FARMER WINERY LICENSE HOLDER AT
SANCTIONED AGRICULTURAL EVENT

1. Applicant must FIRST contact the Department of Agricultural Resources in order to receive certification stating that the proposed event is, in fact, an Agricultural Event. (To apply for Certification please contact the Dept. of Agricultural Resources at 617 626-1720. The application is available on their website:
www.mass.gov/agr/markets/wineries/winery-application.htm)
Proof of certification must be submitted with Licensing Board application.
2. The Licensing Board's application must be signed-off by Boston Police Captain in the area where the Agricultural Event will take place.
3. The Licensing Board's application must be submitted to Licensing Board 3 weeks prior to event.
4. If the license is granted, a fee of \$50.00 is due when picking-up license.
