STRUCTURAL GENERAL NOTES

THE VARIOUS PORTIONS OF THE STRUCTURE ARE DESIGNED TO CARRY THE FOLLOWING LIVE LOADS IN CONFORMANCE WITH IBC 2009, ASCE 7-05 & THE EIGHTH EDITION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE BUILDING CODE (780 CMR):

- 1. GRAMTY LOADS:
- A. FLOOR LIVE LOADS
- i, one and two family dwellings; sleeping rooms: 30 PSF attics: 20 PSF all other areas: 40 PSF
- B, ROOF SNOW LOAD: NOT APPLICABLE
- Lateral Loads: Not applicable.
 No reduction in load demand to lateral load resisting elements.

- 1. BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH ANY DEMOLITION, THE AREA MUST BE SURVEYED AND EVALUATED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO EMSURE THAT NO DAMACE WILL BE MADE TO ANY STRUCTURE OR EQUIPMENT BEYOND THE DEMOLITION.
- 2. PROVIDE TEMPORARY SHORING AND BRACING FOR FLOORS, ROOFS, PIERS, AND WALLS DURING DEACUTION AND MAINTAIN THIS TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION IN PLACE UNTIL THE NEW STRUCTURAL WORK IS COMPLETED AND TIED TO THE REMARKING CONSTRUCTION.

MASONRY LOOSE LINTEL, SCHEDULE 1. PROVIDE ONE ANGLE FOR EACH 4" OF MASONRY THICKNESS FOR MASONRY OPENINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

ANGLE LONG LEG SHALL BE VERTICAL

ALL EXTERIOR LINTELS SHALL BE GALVANIZED.

4. Lintels shall be 12" longer than masonry openings and have minimum 6" bearing on masonry each end.

ALL WOOD MEMBERS SHALL BE NEW MATERIAL AS SPECIFIED IN FOLLOWING NOTES OR DRAWINGS.

2. ALL NEW WOOD MEMBERS SHALL BE SURFACED DRY WITH A MAXIMUM MOISTURE CONTENT OF 19% AT TIME OF DRESSING.

- 3. WOOD STUDS SHALL BE KILN-DRIED, STUD GRADE.
- WOOD STUD WALLS SHALL BE 2x6 AT 16" o/c.
- PROVIDE SOLID WALL BLOCKING SPACED AT 8'-0" 5/c VERTICAL
- ALL WALL STUDS SHALL BE LOCATED UNDER FLOOR JOISTS OR ROOF RAFTERS. PROVIDE DOUBLE STUDS ON EACH SIDE OF ALL OPENINGS UP TO
- 4'-0" WIDE IN BEARING PARTITIONS. PROVIDE ADDITIONAL JACK STUD TO SUPPORT LINTELS. FOR FRAMING OF WIDER OPENINGS SEE DETAILS
- HEADERS FOR WOOD STUD WALL OPENINGS SHALL BE MULTIPLE
- 9, FORM CORNERS WITH A MINIMUM OF THREE STUDS SPIKED TOGETHER.
- PROVIDE SINGLE BOTTOM PLATE AND DOUBLE TOP PLATE IN ALL

POSTS SHALL BE DOUGLAS FIR No. I.

- 12. ALL LUMBER EXPOSED TO MEATHER, IN CONTACT WITH CONCRETE OR MASOURY AND AS NOTED PT' ON THE DRAWNCS, SHALL BE PRESSURE TREATED WITH WOOD PRESSEVATE ALL PRESSURE TREATED WOOD MEMBERS SHALL BE SOUTHERN PINE NO. I OR BETTER,
- 13. PROVIDE DOUBLE JOISTS UNDER ALL PARALLEL PARTITIONS.

14. NOTCHING IN THE TOP OR BOTTOM OF JOISTS SHALL NOT EXCEED 1/6 THE DEPTH OF THE JOIST AND SHALL NOT BE LOCATED IN THE MODILE THIRD OF THE SPAN. HOLES BORED IN THE JOISTS SHALL NOT BE WITHIN 2° OF THE TOP OR BOTTOM OF THE JOIST AND SHALL NOT EXCEED 1/3 THE DEPTH OF THE JOIST.

20. Floor Panels shall be tongue and groove, 3/4" Thick, APA RATED PLYMOOD SHEATHING, EXPOSURE 1 WITH A 48/24 SPAN RATING.

21. EXISTING WOOD SUBPLOORING SHALL BE RENAILED PRIOR TO INSTALLING NEW PLYWOOD SUB-FLOORING.

23 ALL FRAMING SHALL BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE ARCHITECT/ENGINEER OR HIS DESIGNATE PRIOR TO APPLYING NEW

24. ANY WOOD FOUND ROTTED, NOTCHED, SPLIT OR THAT EXHIBIT OTHER STRUCTURAL DEFECTS SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ENGINEER, WHO MAY THEN REQUIRE THEM TO BE REPAIRED, REPLACED OR

2. MULTIPLE LVL BEAMS LESS THAN 12" DEEP SHALL BE NAILED TOGETHER WITH A MINIMUM OF TWO ROWS OF 16d NAILS PER FOOT.

15. WHERE JOISTS ENDS ARE DECAYED, ENLARGE BRICK POCKETS, INSTALL NEW JOIST NEXT TO EXISTING JOIST AND REMOVE DECAYED PORTION OF JOIST.

16. Install solid wood blocking between Joists Platform—Franed over all supporting members; for each 8'-0' of Floor Franing and as required for fire—Stopping.

17. In areas to receive new ceiling, strap the underside of all joists with $1^{\rm h}x3^{\rm h}$ strapping. Shim as necessary to produce a level ceiling.


18. WOOD CONNECTORS, FRAMING ANCHORS, DRILLED-IN ANCHORS AND OTHER ACCESSORIES, SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

ALL WOOD PANELS FOR FLOORS AND WALLS SHALL BE APA RATED PLYWOOD. ORIENTED STRAND BOARD (OSB) IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. ALL PANELS SHALL BE INSTALLED WITH THE FACE GRAIN

22. REFER TO THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE BUILDING CODE NAILING SCHEDULE FOR NAILING AND BOLTING NOT OTHERWISE SPECIFIED ON THE DRAWNICS.






