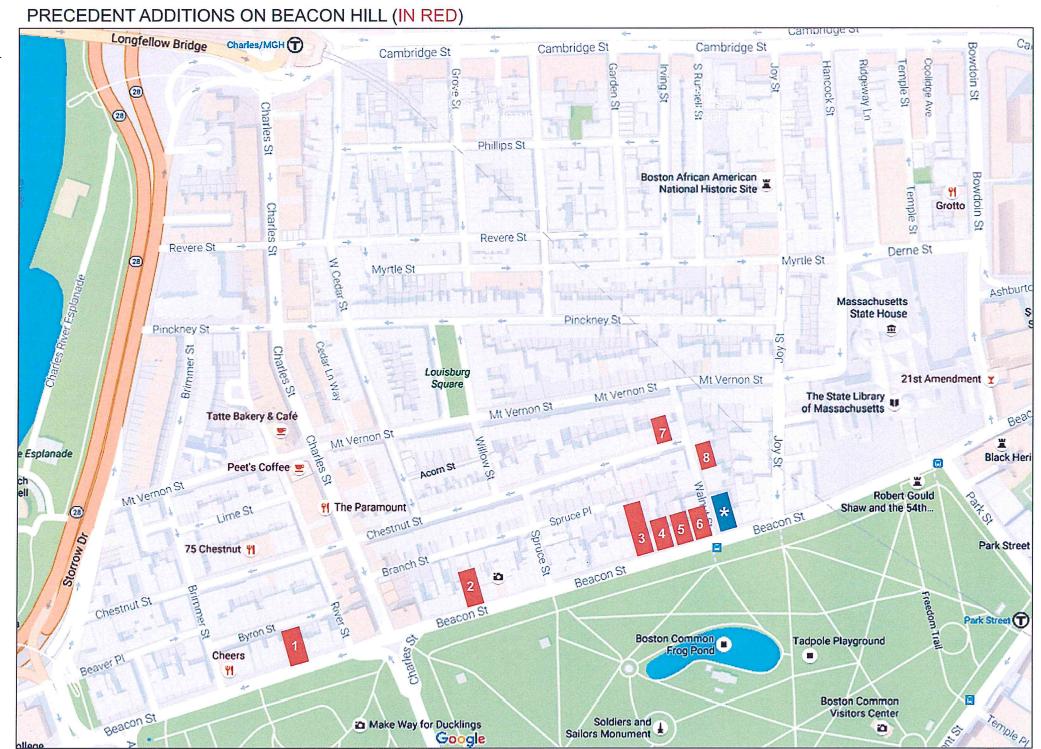

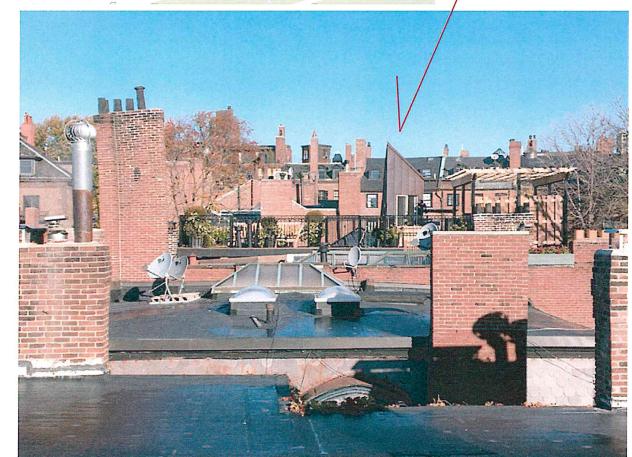


IMAGE 1: VIEW OF 10 WALNUT STREET ROOF STRUCTURE

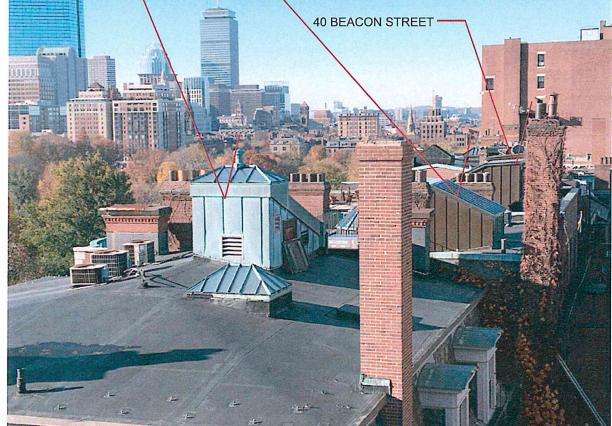


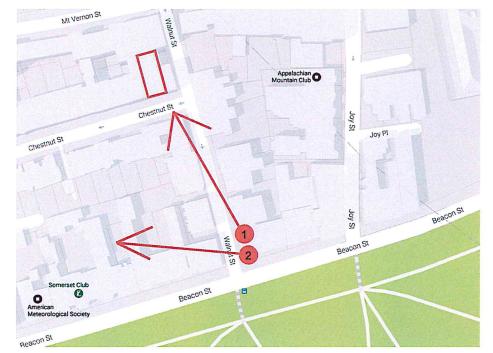
IMAGE 2: VIEW OF 1 WALNUT AND 39 AND 40 BEACON STREET ROOF STRUCTURES

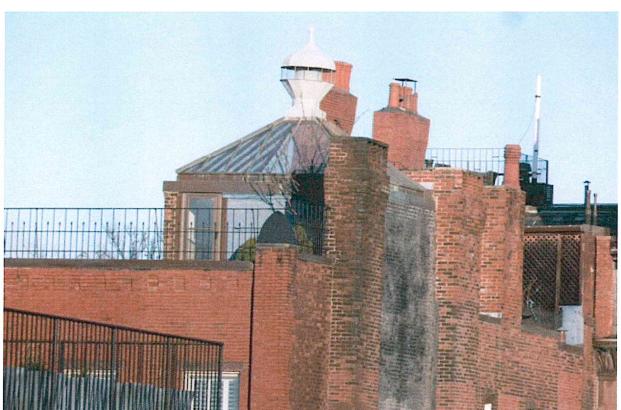

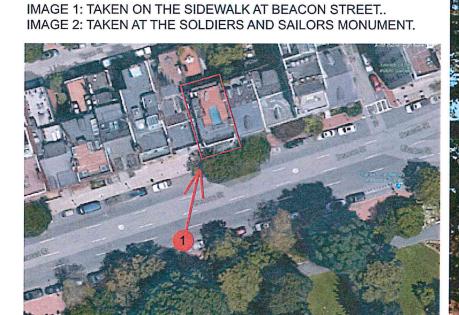


IMAGE 2: 42 BEACON STREET ROOF STRUCTURE

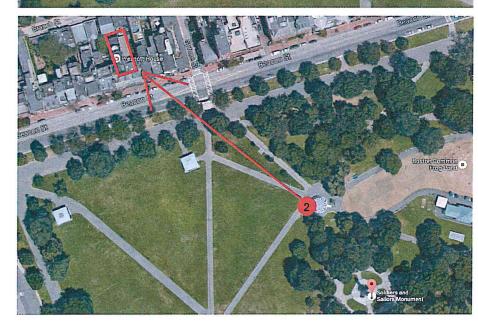

# **NEIGHBORHOOD OUTREACH**

- The most potentially affected neighbors are those in the building itself (37 Beacon St).
- Following consultation, initial plans were changed to minimize impact on the views from the common roof deck and to 'wrap around' the head house.
- An open building meeting was held on 24th October, with no objections raised.
- A letter was received from the Condo Trust on 21st November again indicating no objections to the plans by the building.
- The Condo Trust has agreed to grant the easement allowing breakthrough to the roof.

# **NEIGHBORHOOD OUTREACH**

The other potentially affected neighbors are direct abutters, or those who can see the roof of 37 Beacon St.

- These were all contacted/sent packages in early November.
- The most notable abutter is the Tudor Building (37.5 Beacon St)
  - A letter, photographs, plans and renderings were distributed to tenants by the concierge – no objections received.
- The new owners of 3-5 Joy St were approached personally no objections raised.
- Other abutters were also sent a full package no objections raised.
- BHCA voted non-opposition: December 12, 2016
- Mayor's Office open meeting no opposition: February 07, 2017
- ZBA variance approval: February 28, 2017

# **SUMMARY**

- The owners of Unit 62 37 Beacon St have roof rights (per the master deed) to build on the roof area indicated on the plans.
- A roof deck and modest roof structure allowing access to the deck is planned.
- The roof structure is only minimally visible from any public place.
- The roof structure (allowing egress and small solarium) has a floor area of 122ft<sup>2</sup> internal or 149 ft<sup>2</sup> gross.
- This represents a 0.4% increase in the total floor area of the building (30,260 ft<sup>2</sup>).
- The design is intended to be consistent with the area, and is similar to many other structures which can be seen in Beacon Hill, including from the building's roof.
- The owners believe that the proposed 'urban oasis' will improve the views of those who can currently see the building roof.
- The proposed roof structure will also serve to partially hide the very ugly current elevator headhouse, which will itself also be visually improved.
- The proposed structure has been designed to have minimal impact on any neighbor's views, including due to the 'wrap around' design
- Following extensive outreach no objections have been received.
- The building (residents and Condo Trust) have agreed to the plans.
- BHCA voted non-opposition: December 12, 2016
- Mayor's Office open meeting no opposition: February 07, 2017
- ZBA variance approval: February 28, 2017
