Streetlighting Department Rejected Crown's Application for Double Ft. Point in this Location

Why?

1. All other streetlights along A Street are tall concrete lights
2. A Double Ft. Point streetlight in this location would be inconsistent with the streetscape.
3. When Streetlighting deploys shorter Ft. Point style lights, they are much closer to each other than these style lights.
4. If the lights along the Street were changed, Crown would change this light to match the streetscape.
