The friends of the Harriet Tubman Park proposed to depict the 15 bronze tiles, that are embedded in the sidewalk area near the park, on the electrical boxes. The subject matter depicted on the tiles were inspired by Harriet Tubman's life and the tiles were created by children from the Park school in Brookline and the Childrens Art Centre under the guidance of their art teacher Fern Cunningham.

Twelve of the tiles are located by the statue and the other three are embedded in the sidewall of the Pembroke St. entrance. Hence the reason both of the electrical boxes will be painted with the image of the tiles closest to their respective box. The artist in addition to designing site appropriate artwork, will include the names of all the children that created the tiles.

The project is part of the Friends group and the City's goal of making more information available about the park, Harriet Tubman, and the public art to the many many visitors to the park.




Boxes will serve as a key to the bronze plaques made by students from the Park School in Fern Cunningham Thierrry's art class.


