




SCOPE OF WORK


- This project consists of reconstruction of deficient pedestrian facilities constructed as part of the Central Artery Tunnel (CA/T).
- The proposed MassDOT project includes:
 - 114 Pedestrian Curb Cuts
 - 1.7 Miles of Sidewalk
 - Downtown Boston, South Boston, South End, Seaport District, East Boston, Charlestown
- Construction Cost: \$3.7 Million



SCOPE OF WORK

- Proposed Work (within South End Landmark District)
 - Both sides of Herald Street from Harrison Avenue to Albany Street
 - Project includes the following:
 - 2 Pedestrian Curb Cuts
 - 2 Yellow Detectable Warning Panels for Existing Curb Cuts
 - 475 ft of Cement Concrete Sidewalks
 - Crosswalk Repairs at Various Locations
- All proposed work will be contained within the existing public right-of-way.
- All street furniture will be removed and reset.
- Construction Cost: approximately \$150,000 (within Landmark District)





Limits of South End Landmark District


HERALD STREET

- Proposed Work
 - Reconstruction of existing cement concrete sidewalks and pedestrian curb cuts on both sides of the road.
 - Compliant sidewalks and curb cuts will be retained.
 - Walls and fences along both sides of Herald Street will be retained.







Herald St and Harrison Ave
