Executive Summary

JCDecaux Boston, Inc. operates the City of Boston Coordinated Street Furniture Program. Architectural elements such as Automatic Public Toilets, Bus Stop Shelters, and City Information Panels ("CIPs") are designed, manufactured, installed and maintained at no cost to taxpayers. In 2018, we installed five digital units in connection with our pilot program with a view to expanding the program to more CIPs. With a full-time maintenance staff of fourteen, JCDecaux Boston maintains approximately 447 products throughout the City.

The contractual \$1,500,000 Annual Fixed Fee payment for 2019 will be made no later than March 31, 2019. A check for the 2018 Annual Percentage Fee was issued to the City of Boston on February 28, 2019.
