THE PROJECT & PROCESS

As part of the City of Boston Parks and Recreation Department's continuing effort to provide quality open space and recreation areas for use and enjoyment by all residents of the city. The process will include input and collaboration from the community through a series of meetings facilitated by Boston Parks and Recreation and the design firm, Kyle Zick Landscape Architecture.

Tonight's meeting will include a brief presentation of the project scope and work completed to date including results of the survey and the Drop In Discussions held at the park last week. Community members will be able to offer input regarding the material presented including the program for the park and schematic design. The anticipated project scope includes: updated play equipment including water play, streetscape and entrance beautification, new site furnishings, vegetation management and integration of existing and desired activities and amenities.
