ORDERED: That the Public Works Department, acting on behalf of the City of Boston, be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to Section 53A of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a capital grant award in an amount not to exceed SIX MILLION DOLLARS (\$6,000,000) from the Massachusetts Department of Transportation to be utilized for the reconstruction of Summer Street.
