ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the National Institute of Justice, FY2017 DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction Program award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FORTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$225,044.00).
