WHEREAS: In the FY 18 budget the Boston City Council approved a \$1.06 Billion Boston

Public Schools budget which included a \$116 Million budget for Boston Public

School transportation.

WHEREAS: In the FY17 Budget the Boston City Council approved \$1.032 Billion for the

Boston Public Schools Budget which included a Boston Public School

Transportation budget of \$104 Million.

WHEREAS: In the FY17 BPS Transportation promised a savings of \$10 Million after

implementing efficiency strategies. This savings was not realized.

WHEREAS: The Boston School Committee adopted a new policy that may in the future adjust

bell times which will have an impact on operations and ultimately cost.

WHEREAS: BPS has a legal and moral obligation to provide safe transportation to students

across the district, and THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED: That the appropriate committee of the Boston City Council hold a hearing to

examine the year to date spending of Boston Public School Transportation System

and any mid-year planned adjustments.
