Project Description:

The proposed project is located at 40 Enterprise Street, Dorchester, MA 02125, and consists of the demolition of the two (2) existing structures that currently occupy the Project Site (the Proponent's existing training and office facility and a vacant former office building) and the construction of a four (4) level, approximately 70,000 square-foot training and office facility and two (2) surface parking lots that may accommodate approximately one hundred seventeen (117) off-street vehicles to support the Proponent's operations.

The new structure will include training, educational, assembly, and office space for the Proponent and will replace their existing facility on the Project Site. The building will be approximately sixty five (65) feet tall and positioned on the north end of the Project Site in an "L" shaped configuration. A new pedestrian through block connector will be provided on the Project Site, running northeast to southwest aligned with the adjacent West Howell Street extension being constructed as part of the adjacent South Bay development.
