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PATRICK LINDEN SCHOOL, BOILER REPLACEMENT, DONALD MCKAY, K THROUGH EIGHT, BOILER REPLACEMENT, JAMES INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL AT COPLEY, ROOF REPLACEMENT, AND THE JOHN D O'BRYANT SCHOOL OF -- COSTS INCIDENTAL OR RELATED THERE TO AND FOR WHICH THE CITY OF BOSTON MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT FROM THE MASS SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY, SAID AMOUNT TO BE EXPENDED UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE PUBLIC FACILITIES DEPARTMENT ON BEHALF OF THE BOSTON CITY SCHOOLS, I WOULD LIKE TO ALSO WELCOME BRIAN MCLAUGHLIN FROM PUBLIC FACILITIES AS WELL AS TOMMY WELCH FROM BPS, THANKS. >> THANK YOU.

- >> SO TAKE IT AWAY.
- >> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR.
- >> SO BEFORE TODAY AS YOU MENTIONED TWO ITEMS, BOTH DEAL WITH THE COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOSTON, BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND THE MASSACHUSETTS SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY.

THE MASSACHUSETTS SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY IS THE STATE AUTHORITY THAT OVERSEES THE FUNDING FUNDING OF CAPITAL PROJECTS IN THE MASSACHUSETTS. IT IS A REIMBURSEMENT AGENCY AND FUNDED THROUGH ONE PENNY OF 6.25 PERCENT SALES TAX. THE FIRST STEP IN THE PROCESS IS TO SUBMIT THE STATEMENT OF INTEREST, THIS IS WHAT THE THEY REFER TO AS THEIR APPLICATION. THE SLI ALLOWS DISTRICTS. TO INFORM THE SBA ABOUT CERTAIN DEFICIENCIES WITHIN A BUILDING THAT MAY PROHIBIT THE SCHOOL FROM DELIVERING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM AS DESIRED. THE SOI REQUIRES THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE AND THE SCHOOL COUNCIL TO BE SUBMITTED TO IS, TO THE

SBA, THERE ARE TWO PROGRAMS WITHIN THE SBA'S CAPITAL PROGRAM, IT IS THE ACCELERATED REPAIR PROGRAM AND THE CORE PROGRAM, ACCELERATED REPAIR PROGRAM IS JUST ROOF, BOILERS AND OTHER, IN OTHERWISE STRUCTURAL GOOD BUILDINGS AND PORTS IS MAJOR REPAIRS, RENOVATION OR MAJOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION.

>> THE REPAIR PROJECTS THAT WE ARE HERE BEFORE YOU TODAY, THERE IS -- THERE IS ONE, THE MARSHAL SCHOOL, WHICH WE ARE LOOKING TO -- FOR THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROPRIATE THE TOTAL FUNDS FOR THIS PROJECT.

IT IS A \$5,429,304 WINDOW
PROJECT OF WHICH WE WILL GET
REIMBURSED UPWARDS OF
\$3.3 MILLION FROM THE MSBA.
>> IN JUNE OF THIS -- JUNE OF
2018, THE MSBA APPROVED THIS
PROJECT, THAT PLAYED 90 DAYS FOR
THE CITY TO APPROPRIATE THE
FUNDS FOR -- FOR THE TOTAL
BUDGET.

THAT'S WHY WE ARE HERE BEFORE YOU TODAY FOR THAT ONE SCHOOL. IF WE ARE, WE REQUIRE TWO VOTES OF THE THE CITY COUNCIL BECAUSE IT IS AN APPROPRIATION, AND ONCE THE CITY COUNCIL VOTES IN FAVOR OF THIS, WE WILL THEN MOVE INTO DESIGN DEVELOPMENT IN THE, AND THE PROJECT WILL LIKELY GO INTO CONSTRUCTION IN THE SUMMER OF 2019.

>> THE OTHER ITEM BEFORE YOU IS THE SEVEN SCHOOLS THAT WERE MOST RECENTLY SUBMITTED TO THE MSBA THIS PAST JANUARY.

I'M SORRY, EXCUSE ME, FEBRUARY. SO IN FEBRUARY OF 2017, THE CITY OF BOSTON WORKING WITH THE BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS FACILITIES DEPARTMENT DETERMINED THAT THESE SEVEN SCHOOLS WOULD FIT WITHIN THE MSBA PROGRAM, AND AT THAT TIME IN FEBRUARY THE RAFAEL HERNANDEZ SCHOOLS BOILER WAS SUBMITTED, THE PATRICK LINDEN BOILER, MCKAY BOILER, THE JAMES

OTIS WINDOWS, THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BOILER AND THE SNOWDEN INTERNATIONAL ROOF, AND THE JOHN D O'BRIEN WINDOWS.

THOSE SEVEN SCHOOLS WERE SUBMITTED TO THE MSBA TO WORK IN COLLABORATION WITH BPS, THE MSBA WENT OUT AND VISITED EACH ONE OF THESE SCHOOLS TO SEE IF THEY WOULD BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THEIR PROGRAM.

IN JUNE OF 27 THEY VOTED IN FAVOR OF THESE SEVEN SCHOOLS TO BEGIN WHAT THEY CALL THEIR FEASIBILITY STUDY.

SO WE, WE NOW NEED TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY FOR THIS FEASIBILITY STUDY THROUGH SCHEMATIC DESIGN.

SO LOOKING AHEAD, IF AGAIN THE CITY COUNCIL VOTES FAVORABLY FOR THIS \$600,000 APPROPRIATION, WE IDEALLY GET THE TWO VOTES FROM THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE END OF AUGUST, THE MSBA WOULD THEN AS SIGN AN OPM AND ARCHITECT TO KIND OF EXPEDITE THE PROCESS FOR THESE PROJECTS.

AND DESIGN WOULD OCCUR FROM SEPTEMBER TO PROBABLY EARLY WINTER OF 2019.

WE WOULD LIKELY GET THESE PROJECTS OUT TO BID IN THE WINTER OF 2019 OR SPRING OF 2019, WHICH WOULD PAVE THE WAY FOR EITHER SUMMER OF 2019 CONSTRUCTION AND SUMMER OF 2020 CONSTRUCTION.

IT IS ALL DEPENDENT UPON THE LEAD TIME ASSOCIATED WITH SOME OF THE MATERIALS WE USE IN THESE PROJECTS, WHETHER OR NOT THEY WOULD BE ABLE TO GO INTO CONSTRUCTION IN 2019 OR 2020. >> AND WE HAVE A SIGNIFICANT TRACK RECORD OF BOILERS, WINDOWS, AND ROOFS, WHICH WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO DO IN THE SUMMERTIME.

>> YES.

>> SO TO DATE, SINCE 2014, THE CITY OF BOSTON HAS COMPLETED 12 PROJECTS, TOTALING \$37.6 MILLION, AND WE HAVE BEEN

REIMBURSED \$21.3 MILLION. WE HAVE ONE PROJECT IN CONSTRUCTION RIGHT NOW THAT IS COST JUST OVER 2 MILLION. WE ARE BEING REIMBURSED 1.2. ON THAT PROJECT, ON THAT -- THE RUSSELL ROOF PROJECT ON COLUMBIA ROAD WE HAVE FIVE PROJECTS THAT HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE MSBA TOTALING \$12.8 MILLION, WHICH WE ARE GOING TO BE RECEIVING A LITTLE OVER \$8 MILLION IN REIMBURSEMENT FOR THAT SO IN ALL TOTE PROJECTS COMPLETED AND PROJECTS IMPROVED BY THE MSBA TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET OF THOSE PROJECTS HAS BEEN \$52.5 MILLION, AND THE CITY HAS RECEIVED OR WILL BE RECEIVING \$30.5 MILLION IN REIMBURSEMENT. THE FEASIBILITY STUDY, SCHEMATIC DESIGN IS THE DESIGN OF THE PROJECTS.

>> OKAY.

>> WE HAVE DONE THIS BEFORE?

>> YES?

>> YES.

IT IS A REQUIREMENT OF THE MSBA.

>> I DIDN'T REALIZE THAT.

DESIGN, WE WORK WITH THE
DISTRICT TO FIGURE OUT IF THERE
IS GOING TO BE ANY SORT OF -THAT COULD POTENTIALLY BE ON
THOSE ROOFS.

MSBA DOESN'T REIMBURSE ON PHOTO
-- BUT THAT DOESN'T MEAN WE
CAN'T INCORPORATE AND BRING THE
INFRASTRUCTURE IN PLACE AT A
LATER DATE TO SUPPORT THAT TYPE
OF SYSTEM.

>> AND MY LAST QUESTION, THANK YOU FOR THAT, IS HOW DOES THIS PLAY A ROLE IN BUILD BPS? >> SO A LOT OF THE INFORMATION ON THE SITE VISITS FROM THE 120 SCHOOLS THAT TOOK PLACE LAST SUMMER, WE INCORPORATED THAT INFORMATION FIGURING OUT WHICH SCHOOLS ACTUALLY WOULD FIT WITHIN THE MSBA ARP PROGRAM. THERE ARE CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS TO THIS PROGRAM WHICH IS THAT THE BUILDING SYSTEMS NOT BE OVER 20 YEARS OLD, THE BUILDINGS HAVE TO BE STRUCTURALLY SOUND, EXCEPT FOR THE FACT THEY MIGHT NEED A ROOF, WINDOW, BOILER REPLACEMENT, THEY CAN'T BE OVER CROWDED AND HAVE TO BE USED FOR ACTUAL EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES, CAN'T BE AN ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING, SO WORKING WITH BPS INFORMATION DRAWN FROM THE SITE VISIT MS. AND THE FACILITY TEAM AT BPS WHO LIVE IN THESE BUILDINGS DAY IN AND DAY OUT THEY THOUGHT THESE SEVEN SCHOOLS WOULD BE A GOOD FIT FOR THE MSBA, ARP PROGRAM AND BASED UPON MSBA SITE VISITS THEY CONCURRED AS ALL OF THEM WERE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM. >> THIS FALLS SQUARELY INTO ONE OF THE FOUR BIG QUALITIES OF THE WORK OF BUILD BPS, THE FIRST BEING NEW BUILDS AND MASSIVE EXPANSIONS OF SCHOOLS, WE HAVE GOT THE RECONFIGURATIONS OF RENOVATIONS IT IS A SECOND, WE HAVE SYSTEMWIDE INITIATIVES, THOSE ARE THINGS LIKE MAKING SURE PLAYGROUNDS ARE OFF SCHOOL, THE KITCHEN UP STATES GREAT EXAMPLE, THE FURNITURE, \$13 MILLION IN FURNITURE IS ANOTHER SYSTEMWIDE INITIATIVE, THIS WILL FALLS UNDER CAPITAL REPAIRS, SO IT IS SPECIFICALLY THE ACCELERATED REPAIR PROGRAM FOCUSES ON ROOFS, BOILERS AND WINDOWS AND THOSE ARE THE THREE PROJECTS THAT ARE REIMBURSABLE AS COUNCILOR SAID, ABOUT 60 PERCENT IS WHAT WE ARE LOOKING AT, SO LOOK WORKING ON THESE PROJECTS IN PARTNERSHIP GIVES US A BIGGER BANG FOR THE BUMPS.

>> AS FAR AS THE BUILD BPS TEAM AND HOW WE ARE EMPHASIZING EQUITY IN EVERYTHING WE ARE DOING, WE ARE REALLY TRYING TO MAKE SURE THERE IS GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF WHO GETS THE PROJECTS, NOT JUST ONE NEIGHBORHOOD, KNOWING WE CAN'T POSSIBLY BUILD 50 BRAND-NEW SCHOOLS ACROSS THE CITY AND HE TIME WITHIN THE NEXT TEN YEARS OR SO, BUT AT LEAST ENSURING THAT WE HAVE SCHOOLS WITH THE BEAUTIFUL BUILDINGS, BEAUTIFUL WINDOWS THAT YOU SEE WHEN YOU PASS THEM, I THINK IT IS A REALLY GOOD EXAMPLE WHERE EVERYONE, A LOT OF THE SCHOOLS LOOK DITCH BECAUSE OF THE NEW SCHOOLS BUT MAKE SURE CITIES ALL ACROSS THE CITY HAVE PROJECTS LIKE THIS.
