

## The ABERDEEN ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION DISTRICT COMMISSION

will hold a public hearing:

**TIME:** 4:00 PM

**PLACE:** Boston City Hall – Room 801 (8<sup>th</sup> Floor)

Subject of the hearing will be applications for Certificates of Design Approval on the agenda below, review of architectural violations and such business as may come before the commission, in accordance with Ch. 772 of the Acts of 1975, as amended. Applications are available for review, by appointment, during business hours at the office of the Environment Department. Applicants or their representatives are required to attend, unless indicated otherwise below. Sign-language interpreters are available upon request.

After 5:30 p.m., enter and exit City Hall at the Dock Square entrance on Congress Street (across from Faneuil Hall).

#### I. VIOLATION

19.129 AB 74 Corey Road (Continued from 9/13/2018 Public Hearing).

Applicant: Rabbi A. Hamaoui

Completed Work: Remove non-original vinyl siding and stucco exterior of main structure in white; replace wooden front steps with masonry steps; alter fenestration on front elevation; remove stone-clad foundation and replace with flat stone; cut down trees; install hardscaping and landscaping in front and side yards; construct masonry wall at sidewalk along Corey and Cummings frontage.

#### II. DESIGN REVIEW

19.610 AB 38 Englewood Avenue:

Applicant: Dartagnan Brown

Proposed Work: Repair and restore front façade and side and rear elevations including replacing all windows, repairing chimney, restoring front entry door, and replacing side entry door; restore entry stoop and railing; construct new addition with roof deck at rear elevation; extend side dormer; construct new window wells at front, side and rear yards; and re-landscape property including in the line of the property of the property and the property area.

installing permable pavers at the parking area.

19.606 AB 24 Selkirk Road

Applicant: Travis Blake

Proposed Work: At front façade and side elevations replace wood sidewall shingles in-kind; and construct a 2 ½ - story addition at the rear elevation.

- III. ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW/APPROVAL: In order to expedite the review process, the commission has delegated the approval of certain work items, such as those involving ordinary maintenance and repair, restoration or replacement, or which otherwise have a minimal impact on a building's appearance, to the commission staff pending ratification at its monthly public hearing. Having been identified as meeting these eligibility criteria and all applicable guidelines, the following applications will be approved at this hearing:
  - Applicants whose projects are listed under this heading NEED NOT APPEAR at the hearing. Following the hearing, you will be issued a Determination Sheet to present at the Inspectional Services Department (1010 Massachusetts Avenue) as proof of project approval when applying for permits. ISD personnel will send an electronic copy of your building-permit application to the commission staff for review. (To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

    DETERMINATION SHEET NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE

    ISSUED FOR THE APPLICATIONS LISTED BELOW. The electronic building-permit application as annotated by commission staff will constitute your Certificate of Design Approval; this will be valid for two years from the date of the hearing. The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.
