AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY19 PSAP Grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security.

WHEREAS, the MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN DOLLARS (**\$3,253,317.00**) would fund the costs associated with providing Enhanced 911 Public Safety Answering Point services. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, FY19 PSAP Grant award not to exceed the amount of THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN DOLLARS (**\$3,253,317.00**).
