WHEREAS, the MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS (**\$472,063.00**) would fund the training and certification of Enhanced 911 telecommunications staff. Therefore be it
