WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$172,427.00) would fund the growing need for fire department personnel trained in tech rescue in the cities/towns of Boston, Brookline, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Revere, Somerville, Quincy and Winthrop. ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Federal Emergency Management Agency, FFY17 Assistance to Firefighters Regional Grant award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$172,427.00).
