**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND CEASE Boston FUNDS, AWARDED BY Imago Dei Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the Imago Dei Fund, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$275,000.00**) would fund the Cities Empowered Against Sexual Exploitation (CEASE) Network in Boston, a multi-sector strategy among law enforcement, businesses, the faith community, legislators and survivors who are working in partnership to abolish the demand for human trafficking. Therefore be it

**ORDERED**: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Imago Dei Fund, CEASE Boston award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$275,000.00**).
