WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture and Fair Food Network, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Office of Food Access; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$283,000.00) would fund an expanded scope of work by the Mayor's Office of Food Access beyond the original award including; additional staffing, program evaluation, and additional support and outreach in targeted neighborhoods to provide nutrition incentives to SNAP recipients. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the United States Department of Agriculture, and Fair Food Network' Double Up Food Bucks award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$283,000.00).
